### MERCURY AND OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTES

Certain hazardous dental wastes are sent for recycling and recovery and must be kept separate from clinical waste.

Please ensure you use our range of specialised containers for:

- Waste mercury and amalgam
- Fixer and developer
- Lead foils
- Extracted teeth and caps

### INFECTIOUS CLINICAL WASTE

Place your soft clinical waste in the orange bag provided.

Do not deposit sharps, chemicals or medicinally contaminated wastes in these bags.

Simply tie the bag securely and leave in the appropriate storage area awaiting collection.

**DO NOT PUT ANY MERCURY OR AMALGAM CONTAMINATED WASTES IN THESE BAGS.**

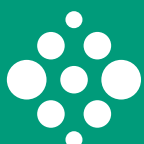
### SHARPS WASTE

Sharps boxes are provided for needles and sharps potentially contaminated with pharmaceuticals.

Please ensure these containers are not overfilled to prevent spillage and injury.

Please close the lid securely and leave in the appropriate storage area awaiting collection.

**DO NOT PUT ANY MERCURY OR AMALGAM CONTAMINATED WASTES IN THESE CONTAINERS.**
